## Hearing God's Voice Intercession & L.A.B.B.

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### CONSTRUCTIVIST THEORY

- We learn in a circle...so don't teach or develop training in a straight line (linear fashion). Discovery is part of the learning cycle.
- People do not learn what they're taught, they learn what they use.
- Three kinds of training sessions/classes: 1. Intro, 2. Practice, 3. Review – All need to be assessed.

### TRAINING KIDS TO HEAR GOD'S VOICE (pptx, book, paper, pens)

- Introduce & Identify "Spirit" to children (pptx & book).
- Experience a demonstration of the Holy Spirit (listening time).
- Practice listening as a group and encourage it individually (journaling).
- Allow for sharing of personal experiences...testimonies.

### THE VARIETIES OF INTERCESSION

- Definition of Intercession: Does not exclusively refer to prayer but action. It is the bringing of two people/worlds together. Synonym: intersection. Examples in the Old Testament:
  - As children begin hearing God's voice, they will not only pray but respond with actions.
  - World Needs, News, Disasters, Unreached people groups, Homeless, Disadvantaged people
  - What's most near and dear to your heart? Share it as a starting point.

### PRACTICING PRAYER FOR HEALING: L. A. B. B.

- L – Listen
- A – Ask
- B – Build Faith
- B – Be Bold

Praying two or three times is not bad or wrong.
